Construction Update - July 31, 2018

Upcoming paving on Seattle Boulevard South; expect temporary driveway blockages

Over the past few weeks, crews have been grinding and regrading Seattle Boulevard South in preparation for paving.

Crews plan to pave the road on Saturday, August 4.

The work is expected to take one day to complete, however, this work is weather-dependent and subject to change. Visit the project website, shown below, to sign up for project updates.

What to expect:

- Work hours: weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. (grading); Saturday August 4 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (paving)
- During paving, individual driveways will be blocked for up to several hours. It is important that new asphalt has enough time to cure after it has been poured. Crews will notify residents with a doorhanger one day prior to impacting driveway access.
- Pedestrian access to homes and businesses will be maintained; please speak with a crew member if you need assistance while crews are working in front of your residence or business
- Restricted on-street parking; please look out for no parking signs
- Temporary road closures as sections are paved; flaggers and signs will direct people through the work area
- Noise, dust, odors, and vibration typical of a construction site
