

## Sewer Pipeline Work in Pacific, Algona & Auburn

Phase B of the Kent-Auburn Conveyance System Improvements Project

**Construction Update – July 31, 2018**

### ***Upcoming paving on Seattle Boulevard South; expect temporary driveway blockages***

Over the past few weeks, crews have been grinding and regrading Seattle Boulevard South in preparation for paving.

#### **Crews plan to pave the road on Saturday, August 4.**

The work is expected to take one day to complete, however, this work is weather-dependent and subject to change. Visit the project website, shown below, to sign up for project updates.

#### **What to expect:**

- Work hours: weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. (grading); Saturday August 4 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (paving)
- During paving, individual driveways will be blocked for up to several hours. It is important that new asphalt has enough time to cure after it has been poured. **Crews will notify residents with a doorhanger one day prior to impacting driveway access.**
- Pedestrian access to homes and businesses will be maintained; please speak with a crew member if you need assistance while crews are working in front of your residence or business
- Restricted on-street parking; please look out for no parking signs
- Temporary road closures as sections are paved; flaggers and signs will direct people through the work area
- Noise, dust, odors, and vibration typical of a construction site
