Construction Update – September 28, 2018

Upcoming restoration along the Interurban Trail in Algona

Crews recently finished installing pipe along the entire project alignment, including along the Interurban Trail in Algona.

Starting next week, crews will begin restoring work areas along the trail to pre-construction conditions. This will include planting vegetation, fixing disturbed surfaces, and replacing fences. Some of the restoration work will be on private properties.

The contractor will get in touch with property owners about fence replacement and yard restoration.

This work is expected to take several weeks. The work is weather-dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

- Hours: weekdays 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Trail access will be maintained
- Large equipment, noise, and vibrations within approved limits
