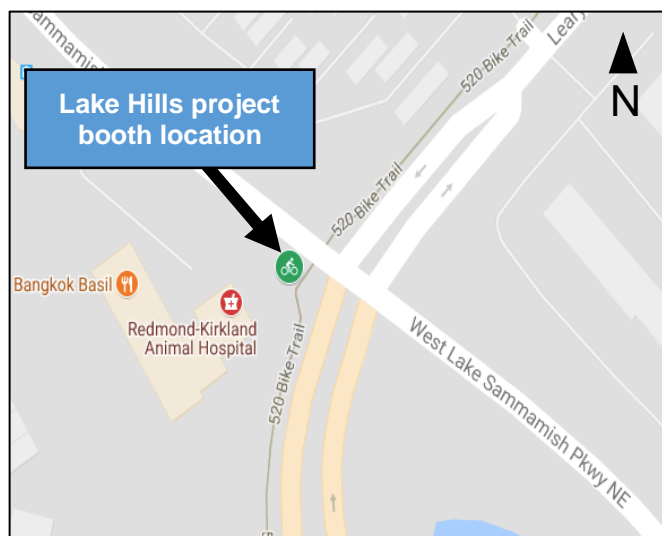
520 Bike Trail
