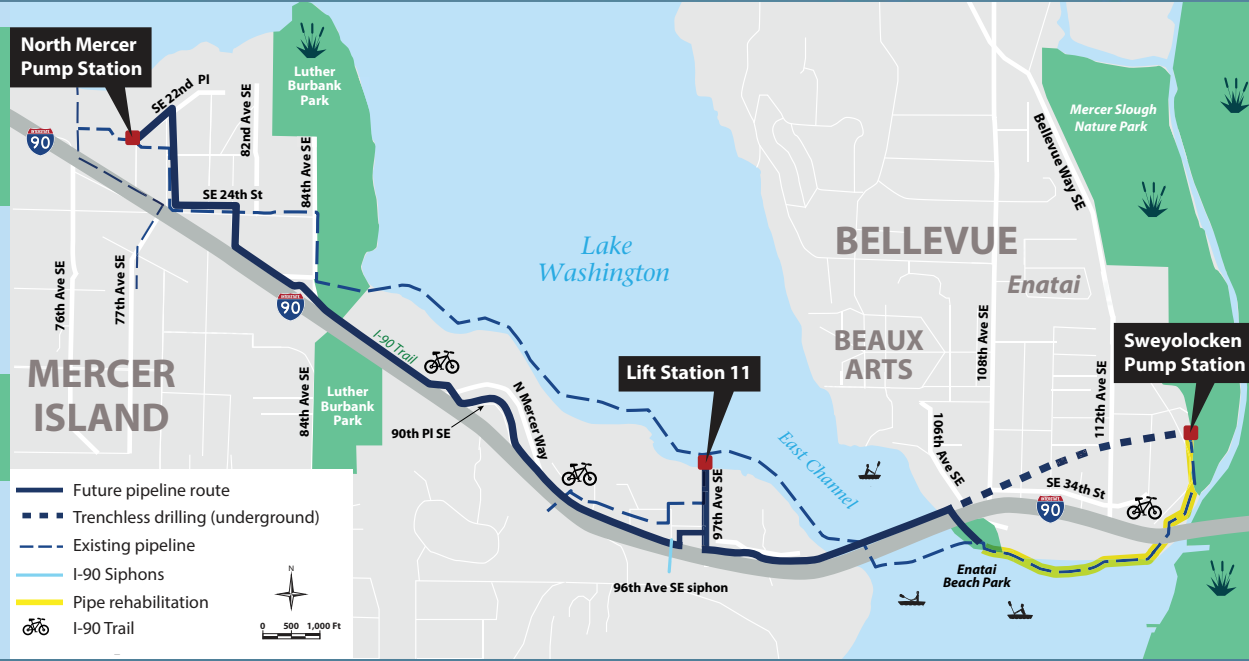
NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project
