Sunset and Heathfield Pump Stations and Force Main Upgrade

June 6, 2019

Construction Update: Full road closure on 164th PI SE beginning as early as Monday June 17

King County's contractor is continuing to investigate and repair the new force main pipe along 164th PI SE, SE 35th PI and near the Heathfield Pump Station. [See last week's update for more details.](#)

Beginning as early as Monday June 17, crews will need to reopen the pit in the road near the intersection of 164th PI SE and SE 35th PI. This will allow them to test the pipe and make repairs. **During this work, 164th PI SE will be closed to through traffic in both directions**, as it was during construction. See map below.

We expect the closure to be in place around the clock for approximately six weeks. Depending on what the contractor finds in their continued investigation, they may need to extend the closure if more repairs are necessary.

What to expect:

- **Current work hours:** Weekdays and weekends from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Please note that work hours may be adjusted.
- **Increased noise and vibrations:** Neighbors can expect noise and vibrations from excavators, shoring installation and vacuum trucks.
- **Around the clock, full road closure of 164th PI SE** currently planned for approximately six weeks beginning as early as Monday, June 17. Before June 17, single-lane closures will continue during working hours.
- **Single-lane closures** on SE 35th PI during work hours.
- **Intermittent single-lane lane closures** on 163rd Ave SE and W Lake Sammamish Pkwy SE.
- **Access maintained for services:** Access to homes and driveways will be maintained and prioritized. Access will be maintained for emergency services, waste pickup, and mail delivery.
