

Construction Update: 164th PI SE closure begins Monday; no roadwork this weekend

King County's contractor is continuing to investigate and repair the new force main pipe along 164th PI SE, SE 35th PI and near the Heathfield Pump Station. **Road crews will not be working this weekend**.

On Monday June 17, crews will begin work to reopen the pit in the road near the intersection of 164th PI SE and SE 35th PI. This will allow them to test the pipe and make repairs. To accommodate this work, **the contractor will close 164th PI SE to through traffic in both directions** (see map below). We expect the closure to be in place around the clock for approximately six weeks. Depending on what the contractor finds in their continued investigation, they may need to extend the closure if additional repairs are necessary.
