



Survey activity week of May 14, 2018

King County's contractor will begin survey work to confirm the location of the County's Coal Creek Trunk sewer pipeline. This survey will help to inform design of a project to replace the pipeline.

You may see surveyors on private property where King County has existing pipe and in some areas of Coal Creek Natural Area.

Project description

King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD) is planning to upgrade a regional sewer line that serves Bellevue and Newcastle. The existing pipeline was built between 1966 and 1991 in an area that looked very different from today, with a smaller population. The pipeline is nearing its maximum capacity and needs to be upgraded to meet the growing needs of your community. When complete, the new sewer will provide safe and reliable service for another 50 years or more.

Schedule

This project is in the planning phase. In late 2017, the project team began field work to confirm the recommended alternative. King County will begin project design in 2018. We expect project construction to begin in 2021 and conclude by 2024. We will provide schedule updates as work progresses.



The Coal Creek sewer line serves the City of Bellevue. The water you use in your home or business travels down the drain to the City's sewer system. King County collects that wastewater from the City of Bellevue and routes it to [South Treatment Plant](#) in Renton.
