Construction update for King County's Eastgate Interceptor Project

Construction has started on King County's Eastgate Interceptor Rehabilitation project, including work within the Lake Hills Greenbelt Park.

In the next few weeks you will see increased activity in the park, including:

- Traffic control, signs and flaggers; there may be some short-term traffic delays on SE 16th Street
- An increase in truck and equipment traveling in and out of the park
- Clearing and tree removal
- Installing erosion control and safety fencing
- Building temporary access roads within the park
- Closing off a row of parking spaces and bringing in a temporary storage container

Wherever possible, we will try to minimize construction impacts and we will restore all disturbed areas.
