North Creek Interceptor construction update:

Construction activities continue on 214th Street Southeast west of Bothell Everett Highway (SR 527)

Construction activities will continue to increase on 214th Street SE, west of the Bothell Everett Highway (SR-527). Below-ground tunneling under SR-527 is nearing completion. Crews have built a receiving pit on the west side for the tunneling machine and will be installing manholes and other facilities.

A large crane will be in place this week to remove the tunneling machine from the ground.

What to Expect During This Work

- Travel lanes may be reduced along 214th Street SE (on the west side of SR-527).
- At times, large equipment will be maneuvering in the street.
 Please use caution.
- Flaggers and signs will direct vehicles through the work.
- Some on-street parking spaces will not be available.
- Approved work hours are 7am to 10pm weekdays, and 9am to 10pm weekends.
- Outside of work hours, there will be noise from pumps and generators.



- It is expected that most of the work will take place weekdays and on Saturdays.
- Expect noise and vibrations during this work.
