

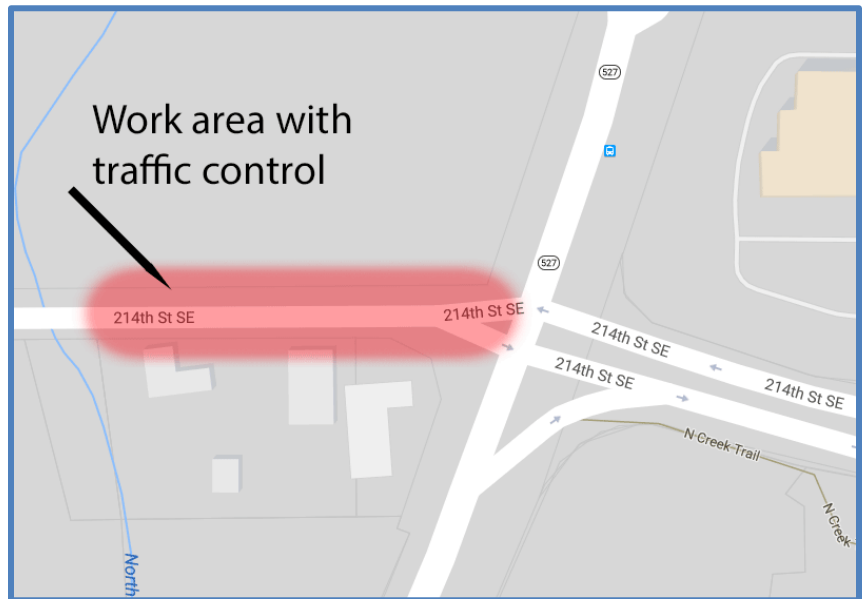

***North Creek Interceptor construction update:***  
**Final Paving on 214th Street SE – June 25-27**  
**West of Bothell-Everett Highway (SR 527)**

King County is nearing completion of construction on the North Creek Interceptor, a major sewer line serving portions of Bothell, Mill Creek, and unincorporated Snohomish County. These improvements will provide added capacity and ensure reliable operations for the future.

- **Final paving on 214th St SE will begin Monday, June 25 and is expected to take two to three days.**
- **Traffic will be reduced to one lane.**
- **Access to driveways will be limited as paving occurs in front of properties.**



**During this work:**

- Approved work hours are 7:00 am to 6:00 pm; expect some noise during this work.
- Paving is weather dependent and could be delayed.
- Crews, trucks, and large equipment will be working in the street.
- Traffic will be directed around the work site.
- Bicycles will travel with vehicle traffic. ***Please drive slowly and obey signs and flaggers!***
- You may want to consider alternate routes if available.
- Please drive slowly and obey signs and flaggers!
