North Creek Interceptor construction update:

Canyon Park Business Center

Final Paving begins June 25 on 223rd Street SE

King County is nearing completion of construction on the North Creek Interceptor, a major sewer line serving portions of Bothell, Mill Creek, and unincorporated Snohomish County. These improvements will provide added capacity and ensure reliable operations for the future.

- **Final paving will occur on 223rd Street SE beginning Monday, June 25, and is expected to take two to three days. The work area is east of 23rd Drive SE and just west of 29th Drive SE.**
- **Traffic will be reduced to one lane. Motorists may experience short delays.**



During this work:

- Approved work hours are 7:00 am to 10:00 pm, expect some noise during this work.
- Paving is weather dependent and could be delayed.
- Crews, trucks, and large equipment will be maneuvering in the street.
- Traffic will be directed around the work site. **Please drive slowly and obey signs and flaggers!**
- Bicycles will travel with vehicle traffic.
- You may want to consider alternate routes if available.
