### King County Near Neighbor Surveys

Residents and Businesses near King County Water Treatment Facilities in Magnolia and Renton

August 2011 EMC 11-4435

#### Methodology



- Surveys conducted via telephone from a central, monitored locations in the daytime and evening hours of July 5<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011.
- A total of 270 interviews were conducted. These results can be projected to the entire business and residential population of the areas interviewed to within the margins of error show below:
  - Magnolia Residents: n=100; Margin of Error (MOE) = ± 10 points
  - Magnolia Business: n=35; MOE = ± 17 points
  - Renton Residents: n=100; MOE = ± 10 points
  - Renton Business: n=35; MOE = ± 17 points

**Note:** Some of the numbers within this presentation reflect "n" size (the actual number of respondents/businesses) and others reflect percentages. Where appropriate, it is noted whether the percentage or "n" was used.

Due to rounding, some percentages may not add up to exactly 100%.

#### Summary



Awareness of the wastewater treatment plants continues to be higher among Magnolia residents and businesses than among Renton residents and businesses.

Magnolia residents have the highest level of awareness at (80%; Aware). Renton businesses have the lowest level of awareness at (57%; Aware).

Since 2009, awareness of the Renton wastewater treatment facility has almost doubled among Renton businesses.

In 2009, a quarter of Renton businesses were aware of the plant. This has increased 28 points to more than half (57%) in 2011.

A strong majority of Renton and Magnolia residents and Magnolia businesses say the treatment plants are good neighbors. More than half of Renton businesses (60%) don't know if the plant has been a good neighbor, which is mostly tied to lack of awareness of the plant.

More than 8-in-10 resident and business respondents in Magnolia feel the treatment plant has been a good neighbor, while 7-in-10 residents in Renton feel the treatment plant has been a good neighbor.

Renton businesses are divided, 2-in-10 (20%) say the treatment plant has <u>not</u> been a good neighbor, 2-in-10 (20%) say it has been a good neighbor and 6-in-10 (60%) say they do not know. Awareness of the plan is lowest in Renton, so the higher level of "don't know" response is understandable.

#### Summary



The most comment reasons cited for why the plants are good neighbors are the lack of any problems generally, no offending odor, and attractive landscaping.

Only one in five (17% to 21%) say they have experienced a negative impact from the treatment plants in their area.

The "negative impact" percentage has remained constant since the last survey. Bad smell, truck traffic and poor air and water quality were cited as the top impacts connected to negative impacts from the plant.

New odor control methods and 24 hour responsiveness to concerns and questions continue to be the highest priorities residents think King County should explore.

The highest priority in Renton and Magnolia among both residents and businesses is to explore new methods to control odor and respond to questions and concerns within 24 hours. These priorities have consistently been the highest in previous surveys.

Respondents in all areas say reducing and controlling odor, reducing truck traffic and trips, and providing more public information are the top improvements King County Waste Water Treatment facilities can make to be a better neighbor.




