### **King County investigating sewer back up near Lake Ballinger Pump Station**

King County is investigating a sewer backup near the Lake Ballinger pump station in Snohomish County. The Lake Ballinger Pump Station is located at 2205 N. 205<sup>th</sup> the Edmonds – Shoreline border.

King County Crews are investigating a sewer backup that occurred yesterday, March 14 near the Lake Ballinger pump station affecting approximately 12 properties adjacent to Lake Ballinger. King County is working with a cleaning contractor. There are no reports of sewage backing up into homes. We are taking precautions and have taken water quality samples from Lake Ballinger and have notified regulatory agencies. The unstaffed pump station moves area wastewater to the treatment plant.



The King County Wastewater Treatment Division's mission is to protect public health and enhance the environment by collecting and treating wastewater while recycling valuable resources for the Puget Sound region.
