

## **Cleanup Response Update - 3/25/19**

Dear Lake Ballinger residents,

Thanks again for your patience as we continue to plan for restoration of the affected properties along the lake. We are writing to give you a status update. We reported last Friday that all clean-up activities had been completed and pipe repairs done. One of the neighbors requested an additional disinfection and pressure washing, so we went ahead and completed that on all the affected properties. The immediate public health threat has been addressed, but please wait to let your kids or dogs play in your yard until restoration is complete.

If your yard was impacted by the overflow, King County will be restoring it. Our team will be bringing in topsoil and sod or lawn seed to replace damaged areas. A landscape contractor has been secured and WTD is working with the City of Edmonds to get a permit for temporary road impacts to SR 104. We will be providing flaggers to safely move landscaping materials in and out of driveways.

We expect to get our permit tomorrow and the work can start shortly after that. We expect the restoration to take approximately two weeks.
