Vashon Drip Field Replacement begins in June

King County crews will be working in your neighborhood to replace structures at the Beulah Park and Cove Drip Field starting in June 2017. The drip field is a small wastewater treatment facility serving the Beulah Park Plat and Cove communities. The field will be surrounded by fencing and neighbors will not have access to the field during construction. Construction is scheduled between June 1 and September 30, 2017. Construction schedule is weather-dependent and work can only be done when it is dry. Work is expected to take approximately three months to complete. King County is responsible for this construction.

What you can expect during construction

- Work crews on site
- Occasional traffic from delivery trucks
- Work hours are weekdays between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- No interruption to sewer services
- Access at all times for emergency vehicles, school buses, and neighborhood residents
- No access to the field until grass is established. Fencing will be in place to protect the newly planted grass
- Typical construction noise on site
