Subject: Modification to Article 2, Collective Bargaining Agreement (Wage and Wage-Related) and Modification to Article 2, Collective Bargaining Agreement (Working Conditions)

### Background:

- 1. King County (the County) and the King County Prosecuting Attorneys Association (the Association) are parties to a bifurcated collective bargaining agreement (CBA) that sets forth the wage and wage-related agreements between the parties. That CBA covers the period of July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2016, and by mutual agreement has been extended to December 31, 2017.
- 2. The King County Prosecuting Attorney and the Association are parties to a bifurcated CBA that sets forth the negotiated working conditions for members of the Association. That CBA covers the period of January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2018.
- 3. Article 2 of the wage and wage-related CBA recognizes the Association as the "exclusive bargaining representative of all full time and regular part-time non-senior deputy prosecutors in the Criminal Division of the King County Prosecutor's Office."

- 4. Article 2 of the working conditions CBA recognizes the Association as the "exclusive bargaining representative of all full-time, regular part-time and job share non-senior deputy prosecutors in the Criminal Division of the King County Prosecutor's Office."
- 5. Historically, the Juvenile Unit has been contained within the Criminal Division and the Association has represented the regular and part-time non-senior deputy prosecutors in the Juvenile Unit.
- 6. On July 5, 2017, King County Prosecuting Attorney Daniel T. Satterberg announced that the Juvenile Unit would become an independent division in the Prosecutor's Office.
- 7. The parties wish to modify both CBAs to reflect that the regular and part-time non-senior deputy prosecutors who work in the newly created Juvenile Division are represented by the Association.

#### Agreement:

1. The parties agree to modify Article 2 of the wage and wage-related CBA as follows:

#### **ARTICLE 2: RECOGNITION**

The County recognizes the Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full time and regular part-time non-senior deputy prosecutors in the Criminal Division and the Juvenile Division of the King County Prosecutor's Office.

- 2. This modification to the wage and wage-related CBA is effective July 5, 2017.
- 3. The parties agree to modify Article 2 of the working conditions CBA as follows:

#### ARTICLE 2: RECOGNITION

The Employer recognizes the Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full-time and regular part-time non-senior deputy prosecutors in the Criminal Division and the Juvenile Division of the King County Prosecutor's Office.

# 4. This modification to the working conditions CBA is effective July 5, 2017.
