Hate Crimes and the Law


- ► RCW 9A.36.080
- ▶ When a person maliciously and intentionally commits one of the following acts because of his or her perception of the victim's race, religion, sexual orientation, disability etc.
 - ► Causes physical injury
 - ▶ Damages or destroys property
 - ► Threatens a group of people or members of a group

Common Hate Crime Issues

- ► Vulnerable Victims
- ► Mentally Ill Defendants
- ► Mixed Motive Cases

Who is being victimized?

- ► African Americans and Gay Men
- ▶ Problem of underreporting



Are Hate Crimes Increasing?

- ► 400% increase between 2012 and 2018
- ► WA has the 4th highest number of hate crimes in the nation.
- ► Majority of Hate crimes in WA occur in Seattle.
