



# 2019 Summer Youth ORCA Pass Application

Summer Youth ORCA Passes will be active **from June 10 – September 9, 2019** and can be used to pay the full fare on all local transit agencies in the region except the Washington State Ferries. The program is only open to current students in Highline, Lake Washington, or Tukwila school districts in 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade who qualify for free or reduced price lunch.

## King County Metro Summer Youth ORCA Program Rules:

- Students are expected to follow transit agency Codes of Conduct when riding. Exercise safety and ride right.
- Report lost or stolen cards to your school or district office. To obtain a replacement card over the summer, students will need to fill out another application and to go to the school district office.
