

WHEELS TO WATER

- **Be prepared for your field trip**
- **Be ready and waiting for your Metro bus at the specified location and time for pick-up from school and your field trip site**
- **Communicate with your bus driver regarding the schedule for the day, any adjustments to return times, etc.**
- **Confirm that your return time to school allows a 20-30 minute cushion before school buses leave to allow for traffic, etc. that could result in an unexpected late return**
- **Be respectful of Metro property and rules – use indoor voices, no eating or drinking, take all trash off the bus with you, thank your bus driver**
- **Metro buses will not always stay at the field site – take all belongings off the bus with you unless told otherwise by the driver**
- **If your bus stays at your field site, you will be separated from it during your field trip – take all necessary medications, inhalers, rain gear, lunches, etc. off the bus with you**
- **Chaperones are required and are expected to encourage proper behavior and etiquette**
- **A minimum of 24 hours cancellation notice required**
