Summary of Engineering and Planning (E&P) Subcommittee May 4, 2017 Meeting for MWPAAC General Meeting on May 24, 2017

Infiltration/Inflow (I/I) Program Update

King County WTD reported that all of the interviews with the component agencies to gather information on the agencies' design standards and inspection practices have been completed. The I/I team wants to express its appreciation to all of the agencies for their cooperation. The consultant team is evaluating the information and will be reporting to E&P this fall, likely at the September meeting. All MWPAAC members are invited to attend the E&P meeting where the results will be presented.

Overview of Strategic Planning Process for Biosolids, Energy, Reclaimed Water, Technology Assessment

WTD staff discussed the process that they will be working on over the next 1-2 years for developing 20-year strategic plans for each of the above 4 topics. The planning processes will run concurrently because of the interrelationship between each of these topics (e.g., energy is derived from the production of biosolids). The development of the strategic plans will be based on answering 3 questions: Where are we now? Where do we want to be? How will we get there? WTD staff will be seeking feedback periodically from MWPAAC at the E&P Subcommittee meetings; information about the strategic plans will also be presented at the full MWPAAC meetings.
