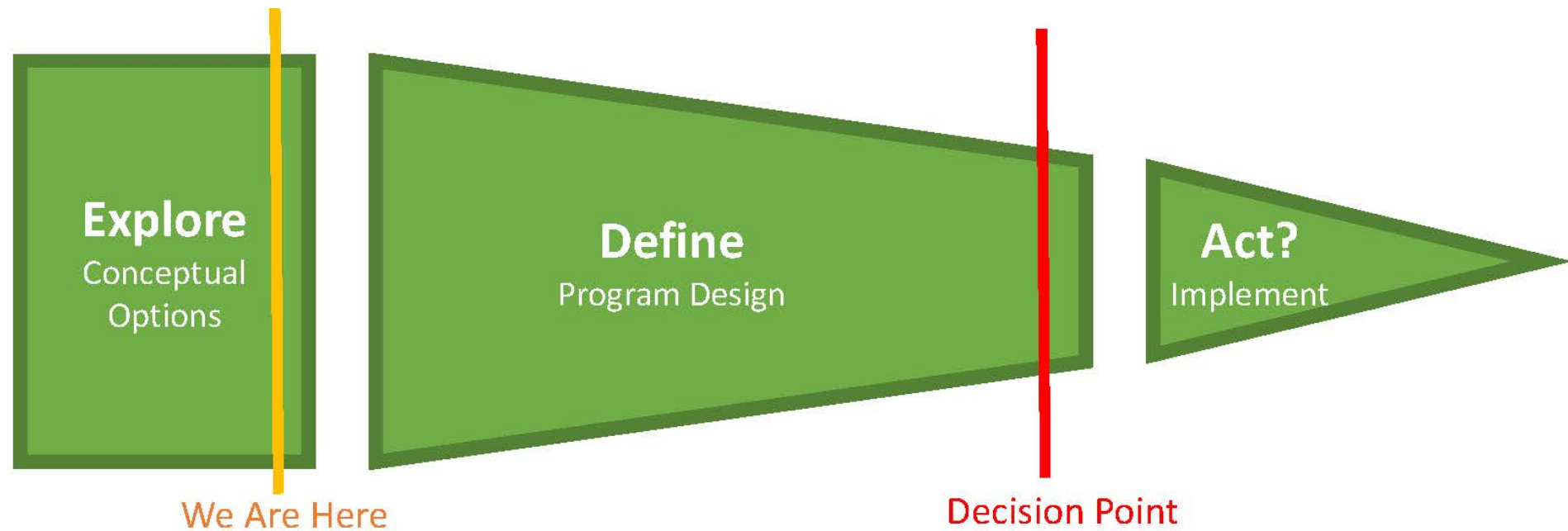

Explore and evaluate I/I Program concepts with the goal of **adopting a strategy that will reduce I/I over time** and reduce the need for capital projects in the separated sewer portion of the regional wastewater system

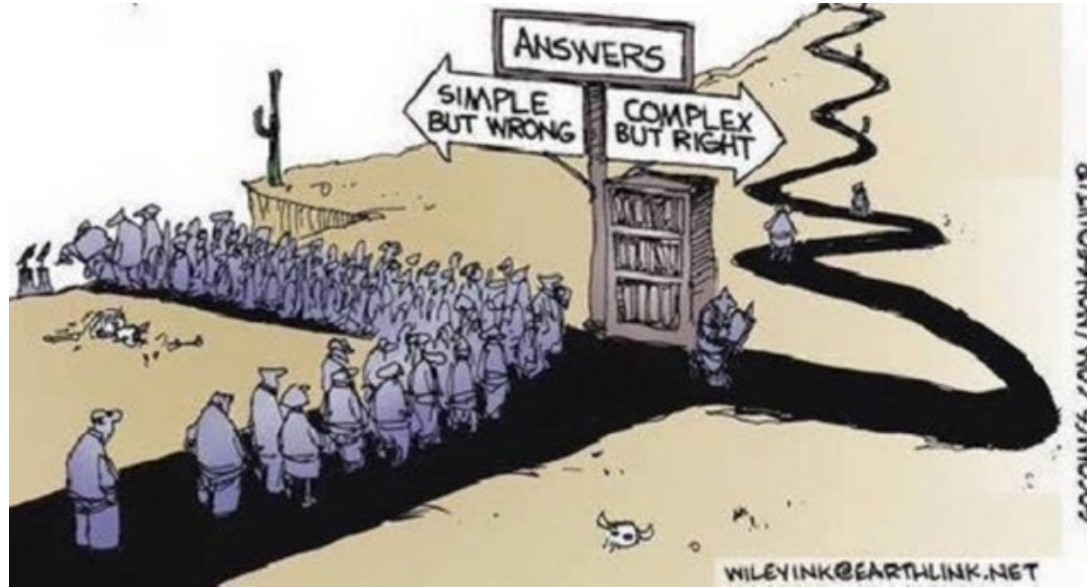
