Right-of-way staking and survey work

Dear Trail Neighbor,

King County Parks appreciates your patience as we move forward in phases with design and construction of the East Lake Sammamish Trail. The purpose of this letter is to let you know that crews from Parametrix will begin surveying and staking the King County right-of-way along the South Sammamish A segment, from SE 43<sup>rd</sup> Way to SE 33<sup>rd</sup> St., during the week of January 19, 2015. These survey stakes will provide King County and adjacent property owners a clear understanding of our respective property boundaries.

Additionally, survey crews will mark the center-line of the proposed trail to align with current design plans which incorporate homeowner feedback . Construction of the Master Planned trail is anticipated to begin this summer and will be solely contained within the County right-of-way. Please do not disturb the survey markers. RCW 58.04.015 provides that “a person who intentionally disturbs a survey monument placed by a surveyor in the performance of the surveyor's duties is guilty of a gross misdemeanor and is liable for the cost of the reestablishment.”

In the coming months, you will also receive a letter from us if you have landscaping and other items located within the right-of-way that will be impacted by construction. The letter will detail specific items within the right-of-way and allow you plenty of time to move or relocate them prior to trail construction.
